ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS (AOD) Bystander Intervention



Save a life, call 911!

If you see any signs of possible overdose call for medical assistance.

California's Good Samaritan Law will protect you.

If you call 911 to get medical assistance at the scene of an overdose, you cannot be criminally charged with simple possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, or being under the influence (CHSC Section 1799.102)

UC Berkeley's Responsible Bystander Policy will protect you.

Students who seek medical assistance for a fellow student involved with alcohol or controlled substances, will not be held accountable to a Student Code of Conduct violation if they have been drinking or using controlled substances themselves.
