

Ergonomics Requirements for Computer Workstations

UCOP establishes requirements for equipment, furniture and accessories purchased for use at UC. Requirements are founded on national and international standards and guidelines, UC-wide ergonomics requirements, and researched-based best practices. These requirements allow UC to provide employees with equipment designed to be sustainable for human health, the environment and provide the best overall value. The requirements listed below are for purchases of used or new computer workstations and will meet the needs of 90% of the population. The tables and chairs on the Be Well at Work Ergonomics pre-approved product list meet the minimum requirements. Width	• Front edge of computer work surface - at least 48 inches (minus 2 inches for pinch points) of usable desk surface (minimum)	
Depth	• Depth of top work surface - at least 30 inches deep (minus 1 inch pinch point) to allow for safe placement of computer equipment on the computer workstation (corner area or rectangle design)	
Height*	• Entire worksurface is user height-adjustable (pneumatic or electric with a one touch control) from 22 to 48 inches (+/- 0.7 inches) or greater from the floor to the top of the work surface (ADA compliant)	
	• If table is pneumatic, forces to adjust table do not exceed 7 lbs	
Clearance under work	• 20.5 inches wide; 30 inches wide for ADA	
surface	• 17.3 inches at level of knee (base or crossbar placement) and 23.6 inches at level of the feet	
Pedestal drawers	• Height: Not to exceed 22 inches to allow for full adjustability	
(mobile/freestanding)	of height adjustable tables	
	• Depth: Take into consideration any cross bars that hang down underneath the desk top to allow for full retraction	
Chair	Provide chairs from the Campus Ergonomics program <u>pre-</u> <u>approved product list</u> which offer a wide range of adjustability	
	• If specifying task chairs not on this list, please contact Be Well at Work Ergonomics at (643-2540) so they can verify the chair(s) meet all the minimum requirements according to the <u>Checklist for Purchasing Chairs at UC</u>	
Customer Service Counters	Customer Sales and Service Counters have different seated and computer workstation requirements due to the interaction with the client. Use the <u>Customer Sales and Service Counter</u> <u>Guidelines</u> when designing these areas.	

*Height-adjustable desks should be considered if one or more of the below criteria is met:

- User performs 4+ hours of computer work throughout the day
- User is required to continuously remain at workstation for 2+ hours
- Multiple users share the same workstation
- New workstation(s) are being created or re-designed
