Covered California is the health insurance marketplace for California residents. Shop and compare plans, get premium estimates, apply online or by phone. New enrollees may also request a call from a certified enroller to assist with enrollment.

Medi-Cal is California's medicaid program offering free or low-cost health coverage for eligible residents. You can apply online at CoveredCA.com/Apply. The single application will let you know if you qualify for coverage through Covered California or Medi-Cal. You can also apply in person at your local county human services agency or by calling Covered California at (800) 300-1506.
