

Viral Respiratory Illness & Return-To-Work (RTW)

EMPLOYEES - RETURN TO WORK INSTRUCTIONS

HEALTHCARE WORKERS (UHS Tang Center and Optometry) who test positive for COVID-19 or other respiratory illnesses must not provide in-person patient care services, or be in clinical buildings for at least 3 days.

Healthcare workers:

- 1. May return to work:
 - a. After 3 days have passed since symptom onset (or test if asymptomatic) and
 - b. At least 24 hours have passed with no fever (without use of fever-reducing medicines), and
 - c. Symptoms are improving, and you feel well enough to return to work
- 2. Mask for 10 days in common areas of healthcare facility (including breakrooms)
- 3. Practice frequent hand hygiene

ALL OTHER WORKERS may return to campus/work after 24 hours have passed with no fever (without the use of fever reducing medications) and your symptoms are improving overall.

***If you feel that your positive COVID test result is work related, please ask your supervisor to fill out the Employer's First Report (EFR) to file a Worker's Compensation Claim. ***
